



## RSL Doorglass Pallet Handling Instructions

RSL uses standard pack and bulk cardboard boxes for storing and transporting our doorglass. Standard pack boxes utilize ECT51 double wall cardboard and bulk boxes are fashioned from heavier, double wall cardboard (AC61 for 64" & AC71 for 80"). When loading cardboard boxes on wood pallets, we secure them with cardboard corners, Poly Banding, and finally stretch wrap. All of our wood pallets are inspected before use to ensure that they are strong and secure.

Freight carriers sometimes do not handle cargo with care and we urge customers to inspect both the cardboard boxes and the pallets before storing at your facility to ensure neither have been damaged during transit. Pallets of 64" doorglass should be moved/lifted with forks that are at least 48" long; pallets of 80" doorglass should be moved/lifted with forks that are at least 60" long.

The U.S Dept. of Labor's OSHA Standard 1910.176 recommends the following:

- Never mix sizes when stacking pallets
- Do not reuse damaged pallets
- Use racks to store stacks of palletized material; avoid overloading
- Prevent workers from standing or passing nearby when pallets of material are raised or lowered
